

Venue

Stuttgart, the capital of the German federal state of "Baden-Württemberg", is spread across a stretch of hilly countryside in the south-west of Germany, including vineyards, valleys and parks. 2.7 million people live in the greater Stuttgart Metropolitan Region, the headquarters of several major companies such as Porsche, Bosch and the Daimler AG. The University of Stuttgart is one of the leading technically-oriented universities in Germany with global significance. The conference is held on the campus "Vaihingen", located 10 km south of the centre of Stuttgart. This campus hosts, among others, the faculties of Natural Sciences and Engineering, the German Aerospace Center as well as several Max-Planck and Fraunhofer Institutes. From the city centre, the campus can be reached by direct public transport within 10 min.

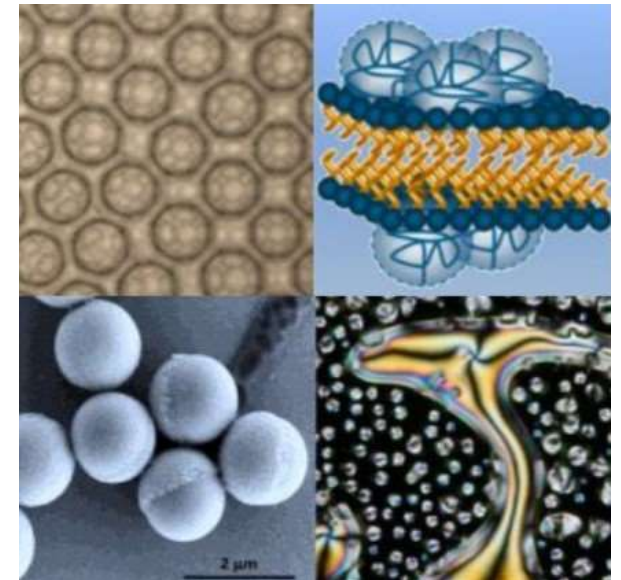
